POSITION OVERVIEW

The Touring Deck Automation Carpenter assists the Head Carpenter and works with the crew to run, move, and maintain all carpentry elements associated with the *MJ First National Tour* safely and consistently.

ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Job responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Load In / Out show at each venue at the highest level possible, conducting tasks in a safe manner while working to stay on the schedule set by the Head Carpenter.
- Regular participation in work calls and rehearsals, as directed by Stage Management and the Head Carpenter.
- Regularly run show cues on a deck automation carpenter track.
- Inspection of show equipment at preset of each performance, reports to be submitted to Head Carpenter and Production Management.
- Verify and help complete periodic inspection of show equipment and document as needed.
- Repair or direct the repair of scenic elements, as needed. Report on inoperable items to Production Carpenter, Head Carpenter, Production Management, and Automation Shop, as necessary.
- Recommend maintenance on scenery and automation equipment as observed during the normal operation of the show.
- Regular communication via phone, email, and onsite.
- Arrival on time and ready for work at the start of each call.

QUALIFICATIONS & REQUIRED SKILLS

- Understanding of scenery automation systems, including machines, electronics, and computer control.
- Theatrical rigging knowledge including counterweight. Chain Motor repair skills are a plus.
- Min 2 years' experience working on an IATSE Pink Contract touring show.
- Team player, able to work long hours in very close quarters with many different types of passionate personalities.
- Scenic carpentry experience is a plus. Including: woodworking, metalworking, basic mechanics, fabric repairs, etc.
- Able to physically lift 75 pounds, comfortable lifting and walking backwards, comfortable walking up and down stairs.
- Must be able to work around loud sounds and flashing lights.
- Knowledge of or experience in road venues throughout the country is a plus.
- Strong organizational and communication skills.
- Understanding of the IATSE Pink Contract rules and guidelines.
