**SHUCKED** is the Tony Award®-winning musical comedy *The Wall Street Journal* calls "flat out hilarious!" Featuring a book by Tony Award winner **Robert Horn** (*Tootsie*), a score by the Grammy® Award-winning songwriting team of **Brandy Clark** and **Shane McAnally**, and directed by Tony Award winner **Jack O'Brien** (*Hairspray*), this corn-fed, corn-bred American musical will embark on its first-class National Tour this Fall.

## **POSITION OVERVIEW**

The Head Audio / A1 position is a full-time touring position that works in tandem with the Assistant Audio (A2) to consistently run, move, and maintain all sound elements associated with the *Shucked First National Tour*.

## **ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

Job responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Working with the Audio team to safely run the audio tracks for the show, under the supervision of the Production Stage
  Manager. This includes the sound checkout / pre-set for the show and all sound cues during the performance.
- Working with the Audio team to maintain/ repair all show equipment to the highest standards.
- Mixing up to 8 shows per week.
- Managing and clearly communicating with local union audio crew at each show stop in tandem with the A2.
- Working with the Audio team to pack, load-out, travel, load-in, and tech all audio between tour stops.
- Working with the show Head Carpenter, Head Electrician, Head Props, and local venue staff to advance all sound aspects of the production at least 4-6 weeks in advance of each engagement.
- Working with the shop to manage and track repairs and RF advance equipment.
- Generating maintenance reports for distribution.
- Working with the Head Carpenter and Head Electrician to manage applicable crew swing and vacation schedules.

## **QUALIFICATIONS & REQUIRED SKILLS**

- A working proficiency of Digico SD7T Consoles and Qlab.
- Detail-oriented, willing to complete both complex and menial repetitive tasks with exacting precision.
- Technical Theatre experience, specifically national touring experience is a plus.
- Mastery of general computer troubleshooting.
- General knowledge of sound equipment troubleshooting.
- Team player, able to work long hours in very close quarters with many different types of passionate personalities.
- Willing to work in an 8-show a week schedule. Often called in for rehearsals outside of the show schedule.
- Must be able to work around loud sounds and flashing lights.
- Willingness to work in dark often cramped/ closed spaces.
- Strong ability to lead and instruct a crew of up to a dozen people, with varying skill levels.
- Able to physically lift 75 pounds, comfortable lifting and walking backwards, comfortable walking up and down stairs.
- Excellent practical, problem-solving, organizational, planning and time management skills.
- Must have excellent Emotional Intelligence (self-awareness, motivation, social, empathy, and self-regulation skills).
- Experience working with or around celebrities/ high profile people.
- Any film/ TV/ dance/ trade show/ industrial/ live performance experience a plus.
