California law makes clear that lock-outs are illegal. A landlord shall not prevent the tenant from gaining reasonable access to the property by changing the locks or using a bootlock or similar methods. *California Civil Code* §789.3(b)(1). Tenants may only be removed from the property by a sheriff acting pursuant to a court order.

An unlawful lockout is punishable as a crime under *California Penal Code* §418.00. In addition, you may be liable for statutory penalties of no less than \$250.00 per each separate cause of action, plus additional damages and costs. *California Civil Code* §798.3(c).

Please comply with your obligations and refrain from any further attempts to lock me out of my home.
