**On Tuesday, June 6, Vote Phil Murphy for Governor**

Dear Local 1014 Member:

On Tuesday, June 6, a critical election will be held in New Jersey. After eight disastrous years of Governor Christie, we will have an opportunity to ensure the next governor will turn New Jersey around by standing up for working people, good jobs, and strong public services. **Your union has reviewed the records and positions of the candidates running for governor, and we recommend a vote for Phil Murphy in the Democratic Primary for Governor.**

Murphy has pledged to work with our union to fully fund our pensions, and enact a millionaire's tax and close corporate tax loopholes in the first 100 days of his administration to help pay for it. Instead of just shifting costs onto workers like Governor Christie has done, Murphy will work with our union to make quality health care more affordable.

Phil Murphy will stand up to Wall Street. Not only has he pledged to work with our union to keep hedge fund managers from profiting from our pensions, he will push legislation to ensure hedge fund managers pay the same income taxes worker do, and he will create a public bank that will take money out of Wall Street and put it to work for the people of New Jersey.

Murphy will stand up to corporations receiving generous tax breaks that are shipping CWA call center jobs overseas. And he will work to pass policies benefiting all workers, such as a \$15-hour minimum wage, equal pay for equal work, paid sick leave for all workers, and a child care tax credit for working parents.

These are challenging times. We need someone to rebuild after the damage caused by Chris Christie, and we will need a strong governor to stand up to Donald Trump 's divisive agenda by pushing strong, pro-worker legislation in our State House. Phil Murphy is that candidate.
