Salary stagnation for long-serving Lecturers (equity adjustments of \$1k/year of service) Minimum salaries (substantial increases to minimums)
Going in and out of benefits eligibility (averaging appts to maintain eligibility)
Parental accommodation pay and child care subsidy (new proposals)
Teaching at multiple institutions (moving more part-time Lecturers to full-time)
