

Failing CCEA Resorts to Violence, Rejecting the Will of its Members Exercising Right to Drop Membership

NEA of Southern Nevada will provide legal support to ensure members' decision to drop is recognized

(Las Vegas, NV) - NEA of Southern Nevada (NEA-SN) strongly condemns CCEA's vicious and violent rejection of membership termination and dues revocation notices that took place Wednesday, July 11 at their offices. This morning the first of several deliveries containing hundreds of termination notices were brought to the Clark County Education Association (CCEA) by a process server. The process server reported to NEA-SN the notices were violently rejected by CCEA. The process server said CCEA staff and representatives attempted to refuse delivery and threw the boxes at the process server as she returned to her vehicle. NEA-SN verified CCEA abandoned the boxes that contain personal and sensitive member information in the parking lot. The process server relayed to NEA-SN that she would be filing a formal report of the incident.

Despite CCEA's violent attempts to maintain their falling membership numbers, the termination notices have been accepted by the Clark County School District Human Resources Office and the local office of the Employee Management Relations Board (EMRB). CCEA has also received a mail delivery of the termination notices by the US Postal Service. NEA-SN condemns CCEA's actions on behalf of the process server who was merely doing her job, and on behalf of the hundreds of members who were exercising their contractual and legal right to leave CCEA. NEA-SN calls upon CCEA to immediately take all necessary safeguards to protect member information, the right of members to choose the union that best represents them, and their right to drop. NEA-SN will take all necessary measures, including legal action, to ensure that all membership terminations and dues deduction revocations are honored.
