COLORADO

[Fair Maps Colorado](#) stands behind Amendments Y and Z. Amendment Y would apply to the redistricting of congressional districts, while Amendment Z would apply to state legislative districts. The amendments are the product of bipartisan negotiations and were referred to the voters by the entire Colorado State Legislature.

FLORIDA

[Second Chances](#) in Florida is advocating for the passage of Amendment 4, which would automatically restore voting rights to those who have done their time and paid their debts. This would restore the eligibility to vote to approximately 1.4 million returning citizens in Florida.

MARYLAND

In [Maryland](#), residents will be voting on a legislatively referred constitutional amendment to allow eligible voters to register to vote and cast their ballots on Election Day.

MICHIGAN

[Voters Not Politicians](#) are urging residents to vote yes on Proposal 2 to establish an independent redistricting commission. The Voters Not Politicians solution has a set of strict criteria; including that districts be geographically compact, contiguous, and take communities of interest into account. This set of criteria ensures that the Commission does not manipulate election map lines with partisan bias.

MICHIGAN

In Michigan, [Yes on Proposal 3/Promote the Vote](#) would ensure that every eligible person can vote and every vote will count. The proposal would provide a common-sense approach to remove barriers for working families, safeguard elections and put voters first.

MISSOURI

[Clean Missouri](#) worked tirelessly to get a combined redistricting and ethics reform measure on the ballot in November. If passed, Amendment 1 would amend the state constitution to change the process and criteria for redrawing state legislative districts during reapportionment, change limits on campaign contributions and establish limits on gifts that lawmakers and their employees can accept from paid lobbyists.

NEVADA

In [Nevada](#), automatic voter registration (AVR) via DMV (Department of Motor Vehicles) initiative is on the ballot. AVR is a common-sense solution that makes our voting systems more secure and makes voter registration more convenient for eligible voters.

UTAH

In Utah, the [Better Boundaries](#) campaign is urging residents to vote yes on Proposition 4. It would create an independent redistricting commission that will make recommendations to the legislature on congressional, legislative and school board districts.

There are also Voter ID measures in [ARKANSAS](#) and [NORTH CAROLINA](#)
