The Prince George's County Educators' Association Foundation and the Minority Affairs Committee have established a scholarship fund for minority students who will graduate from a Prince George's County public high school in the 2018-2019 school year. Scholarships are a minimum of \$500.00 and will be given in recognition of outstanding academic performance, leadership qualities, and financial need.

The two types of scholarships offered are: *Merit and Merit/Need*

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

You are eligible to apply if:

- *You are a 12th-grade student who has attended Prince George's County Public Schools for at least four years;
- *You are a graduate of a Prince George's County public high school by June 2019;
- *You are accepted during the 2018-19 school year at an accredited college/university, trade/technical school or post-secondary institution;
- *You are in good academic standing with at least a "B" average or the equivalent in grades 9-12;
- *You are a good citizen at school and in the community;
- *You are able to provide evidence that you have exhibited leadership qualities in school and/or your community.

Applicants for a Merit/Need scholarship should also supply evidence of financial need.

All applicants must submit the following:

- *The attached two-page application;
- *A current resume;
- *An up-to-date official transcript that includes grades received so far in applicant's senior year;
- *A recent professional or graduation photograph (non-returnable, unless requested in advance)- please do not provide a photocopied picture; and
- *Three (3) references (two from a teacher or counselor and one from a member of your community).

[Applicant and applicant's parents/guardians grant(s) the PGCEA Foundation permission to use the applicant's likeness in a photograph in any and all of its publications, including website entries, without payment or any other consideration. Applicant, along with parent(s)/guardian(s), understand(s) and agree(s) that these materials will become the property of the PGCEA Foundation and will not be returned.
