You are eligible to vote if you meet the constitutional requirements for voting and are listed on the official SERC eligibility list. Even if you are not on the official eligibility list, you may still be eligible to vote a challenged ballot on the date, time and place identified above.

If you vote in person, you will deposit your sealed ballot into the ballot box and the Local Election Committee will later mail your sealed ballot to the American Arbitration Association post office box at the conclusion of all in-person balloting.

If you are unavailable to vote on the date and time above, you may request a replacement mail ballot by calling the office of the American Arbitration Association at 800-529-5218, or emailing UlerioS@adr.org.

To be counted, all mail ballots must be received in the AAA post office box by no later than 5 pm on Monday, December 9. If your replacement mail ballot is not received in the AAA post office box by December 9, 2019 it will not be counted.
