



## SHOESTRIKE FOR THE CLIMATE

**To restart the economy after the pandemic, be “climate smart.”** In the Paris Agreement, the countries of the world agreed to limit the temperature rise to well below 2 degrees with an effort to succeed to limit to 1.5 degrees.

Emissions should be reduced by at least 10 percent annually. We are risking rampant climate change, as large parts of the planet will become uninhabitable and hundreds of millions of people will be forced to flee.

Demand that politicians and rulers act to create sustainable and secure societies:

- **Put people and environment first.** Create sustainable jobs and help people retrain where needed. Leave the forest and safeguard biodiversity.
- **Leave the fossil economy.** Ensure that support packages and financial incentives help to achieve the goals of the Paris Agreement and the UN's global sustainability goals. Stop subsidizing fossil energy and raise the price of emissions.
- **Declare a climate emergency.** Once declared, hold the politicians accountable.

**You can make a difference!** Influence your politicians. Measure your climate footprint and see if you can reduce your ecological footprint. Get involved in an environmental organization.

**Why SHOE STRIKE?** We do not set - we change! Shoe strikes around the country are becoming a way to make visible to all those who would have manifested for a climate-smart reboot if we could have walked out on the streets together.
