

Let us all #FightFor1point5 !

On Saturday, 12th of December, the United Nations come together to celebrate the fifth anniversary of the Paris Agreement. But there is no reason for celebration. Every single government fails to contribute to a 1.5 degree pathway. If this continues, the climate crisis will become uncontrollable resulting in the degradation not only of our natural resources but also of human life. We cannot allow that to happen.

So we will have to stand together and protest: **We #FightFor1Point5 !**

We need a Global Climate Uprising that will challenge the power of entrenched politics and industries to enable a just transition towards an economic system that respects the natural boundaries of the earth and puts social interests before profit of the rich.

On Friday December 11th and Saturday December 12th we call **all parents, children, employees, employers, activists, NGOs** - all that have understood the urge to act - to stand against the deterioration of our planet and the violation of our right of a secure future.

So everyone around the world, spread the message, take part:

1. Light candles, use LEDs or your phones, to form the words "Fight for 1 Point 5" and show that we are not celebrating but instead are holding a vigil, to show that we are not shutting up: our house is on fire
2. Post pictures of your action including the hashtag **#FightFor1point5** and connect with other actions worldwide
3. Check out related online petitions, lifestreams, and workshops

Very important: **Mobilize without conflicting your local covid-restrictions!**

Only strike in small groups or with the adequate physical distance if you are allowed to do so. Get creative - protests can be done on a large scale outside but also alone in your home.



This is a crucial point in time and we need everyone to be with us and to strike in whatever way is safe and possible! We have only this one planet and only this one future. Actions taken today decide about tomorrow. We are not intending to let this chance pass by.
