OUR FOOD SYSTEM IS UNDER THREAT

The Agriculture Bill has now become law. Unfortunately, the amendments that would have prevented the importation of food produced to lower environmental, food safety and animal welfare standards were **blocked by Conservative MPs** - including our own.

If these **low quality food imports** reach our shelves it would affect us all as consumers. It would also undercut UK farmers on price, forcing them to lower their standards to compete. The UK would be complicit in animal welfare and environmental abuse in other countries.

Buying **high quality**, **locally grown food** supports our local farmers, is better for the environment and is better for our health. Short supply chains are more resilient to the threats to food security posed by pandemics and climate change.

Local Green campaigner, **Nick Morphet**, feels so strongly about this that he helped a local organic veg box scheme with their deliveries during lockdown.

Ginnie created **Hexham Fresh Food Bank** in April, and dozens of gardeners have since signed up to the scheme. Instead of going to waste, their surplus food is distributed via the **West Northumberland Food Bank**.

Coronavirus has made life harder for those who rely on public transport, but Green campaigner **Nick Morphet** is working hard to provide solutions. When the council announced a trial road closure in Hexham town centre, some residents with mobility issues felt that they would struggle to get into town. Nick and his friends responded by creating **Active Travel Tynedale** to raise funds for an electric cycle rickshaw. They hope to use this to provide a clean, green taxi service around town. They also hope to provide an electric cargo bike delivery service.
