WHERE: Mostly online teach-in via Zoom and Facebook

WHY: To educate and promote the planned Global Day of Action on Saturday 26 June 2021

Sonya McKay says the event will promote a worldwide day of action planned for Saturday 26 June 2021. “The time has come *now* for serious and significant actions to achieve climate action goals *by* 2030, not to wait and start then. We need to really connect, communicate, and unite together to attain zero carbon emissions and 100-percent renewable energy by then, and break free from the existential threat caused by fossil fuels.” The event will feature short talks by activists in Sweden, USA, and elsewhere, videos, and a global petition to the United Nations. It will also include a contest for young people and adults to write climate crisis op-ed essays, perform new songs, make short videos, design posters, etc. Some pandemic-compliant small protests – including a ShoeStrike in New South Wales in Australia -- may also be livestreamed
