## HOUSE BUILDING IS GETTING OUT OF HAND

Local people need affordable housing. Too often poor quality houses are being built in the wrong places with insufficient drainage, sewerage, health services and school places to support them.

## TRAFFIC CONGESTION & AIR QUALITY

More housing without improved public transport leads to traffic congestion down narrow village and country roads. More traffic leads to poorer air quality. This occurs especially at peak times such as school drop off and collection, for example in Brundall and Cantley. We call for safe and active travel to and from schools and the regular monitoring of air quality.

Kevin Hunt, landlord of the Ram Inn, Brundall, says, "I am very concerned at cars speeding right outside the pub". He adds, "Cars sometimes park directly on the road causing an additional hazard." We will work with residents and businesses to introduce Low Traffic Neighbourhoods and restrict speeds on this busy road.
