



Job Posting: Candidate Services Coordinators

The New Hampshire Senate Democratic Caucus runs State Senate campaigns with a sole goal of regaining the New Hampshire Senate majority. To build into the 2022 election cycle, we are seeking dynamic, dedicated, hard-working individuals to provide services to incumbent and frontline members as they build their campaign year presence during the legislative session. The **Candidate Services Coordinators** will work closely with senior staff, the legislative leadership team, and individual members to draft and execute plans for their electoral success in November 2022.

Primary Responsibilities:

- Assist NHSDC in developing and executing the promotion and development of assigned incumbent members and challenger candidates.
- Plan, schedule, build and manage small- and large-scale virtual and in-person town hall events ranging from small social gatherings to large events with 50+ attendees.
- Manage member social media presence, conduct all follow-up, and work with NHSDC staff on principal highlights for larger Democratic audiences.
- Build on existing volunteer base and town committee infrastructure with new district maps and using voter database by identifying and recruiting new volunteers and activists.
- Organize volunteers and activists around priority legislation, including by text and phone.
- Draft online/email fundraising solicitations and calls-to-action.
- Staff members at finance-related events.

Minimum Qualifications

- Strong commitment to electing Democrats to state government.
- Bachelor's degree and one cycle statewide, congressional, or legislative campaign experience.
- Position based out of Concord, NH office for the duration of the campaign cycle.
- Must have a car (position will at time require travel around the state).
- Exemplary time management, planning, and organizational skills.
- Detail-oriented and able to prioritize and manage multiple projects and principals.
- Strong written and oral communication skills, including proficiency in social media and G-Suite.
- Work extended hours, including nights and weekends, as needed.

Preferred Qualifications

- Experience in and knowledge of the political landscape in New Hampshire.
- Two or more cycles of experience working directly with a candidate.

This is a great opportunity to gain experience in all facets of political campaigning and to experience New Hampshire's grassroots campaigning first-hand. Salary is commensurate with experience and qualifications. Health, dental and vision available. This position will begin January 2022 and end Nov. 25, 2022.
