The New Hampshire Senate Democratic Caucus runs State Senate campaigns, in order to maintain and grow our majority. For the 2022 election cycle we will be looking for a dynamic, dedicated, hard-working individual to service our campaigns as primary liaison between candidate campaigns, Caucus Leadership and consultants.

Responsibilities/Duties:

- Work with consultant to develop highly tailored campaign plan and work with campaign to implement the plans:
 - Field Plan (including community organizing)
 - Fundraising Plan
 - Plan for Victory (strategic calendar)
- Field:
 - District & Town Analysis
 - Work with campaign to implement field campaign
 - Door knocking planning, and partner group activation
 - VAN management
 - Training on volunteer recruitment, persuasion scripts, candidate motivation
- Personnel:
 - Recruit and train qualified campaign managers
 - Develop team work ethic between candidate, staff and consultant
- Tracking and Campaign Management
 - Work with campaign to track field and fundraising weekly, and then daily
 - Produce reports on campaign progress for caucus leadership

Skills /Experience needed:

- Ability to plan and use time according to a plan
- Excellent oral and written communication skills
- Ability to work nights and weekends
- Access to a car and available to drive for work
- Experience working on state legislative campaigns or other campaigns before, ideally in a campaign management position
- Ability to think outside the box
- Ability to work as a team
