What strings are attached?

Upon completion of a funded project, a brief report must be filed with the ECSU-AAUP Office. This report must include documentation of how the scholarship funds were spent. Failure to appropriately spend the scholarship funds received for this research project will result in a report of academic misconduct to the ECSU Judicial Officer.

The Jean Thorsesen ECSU-AAUP **Scholarship** is named after Jean H. Thoresen (deceased), a devoted member of the AAUP, a tireless worker for AAUP ideals, an ECSU-AAUP chapter president, and a professor of Sociology.



How Do I Apply?

Submit a complete application consisting of:

- 1. **Application Form** available on the ECSU-AAUP website, or go to www.ecsuaaup.org/wp-content/ uploads/2012/09/Thoresen-Scholarship-Application-Form-rev.pdf
- 2. Project proposal narrative:
 - a. Limited to four (4) typed pages using 12-point font, doublespaced, with 0.7 inch margins.
 - b. A clear set of goals/objectives for the project.
 - c. An appropriate and feasible methodology or plan for conducting the project, including a timeline.
 - d. Likelihood of significant outcome, such as publication, presentation at a conference, performance or exhibition.
 - e. Evidence of a well-focused and worthy project presented in relationship to the applicant's field of study.
- 3. **Proposed budget** with documentation/justification of costs and relation to proposed project.



- 4. **Curriculum vitae** (Resume) limit to 2 pages.
- 5. **Letter of recommendation** from the supervising faculty member evaluating the feasibility of the project as proposed by the student, and the student's ability to complete the project.
- 6. Submit one hard copy AND one *electronic file* of the complete proposal delivered by the deadline to:
