## GYPSY & TRAVELLER SITES – A STRATEGY NEEDED

The proposal for a Gypsy and Traveller site at the A47 North Burlingham junction has left residents concerned. It is clear from the current consultation for sites, which ends on 20th March, that a long-term strategy for the provision of sites does not exist and is urgently needed.

The proposed site is unacceptable in so many ways and Green councillor in Brundall ward, Jan Davis, said so when it came up for scrutiny at a council meeting. Despite putting forward valid objections this site was still included for public consultation. More Greens like Jessica on the council will ensure greater transparency and give residents a greater say in decision-making. Jessica will continue to campaign against this unsuitable site.

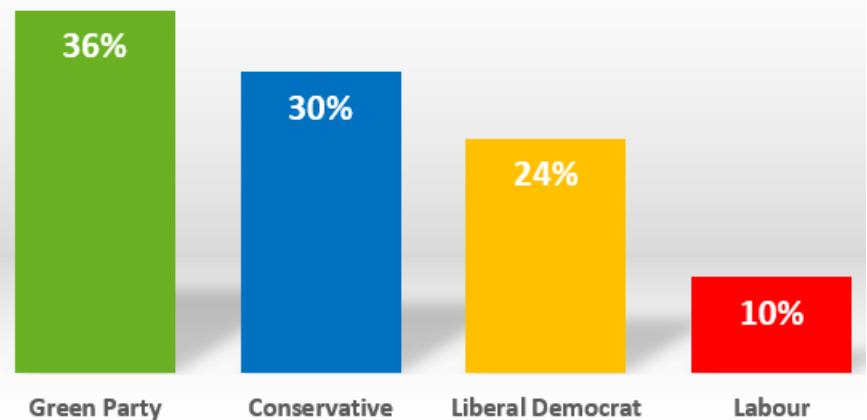
