FURTHER HOUSING DEVELOPMENTS HALTED

In March 2022 Natural England ordered a halt to further developments involving overnight accommodation (i.e. housing). No further housing can be built until measures are put in place to address the issue of nutrient overload in the water courses of the Broads Special Area of Conservation. Developments that had already received approval before the halt was imposed are still going ahead. But any planning applications for new housing will have to include measures to limit additional nutrients entering water courses. There are no easy solutions. The overload of nutrients in our local rivers is a clear demonstration of the limits to growth. We will continue to closely monitor the situation to ensure any proposed solutions are practical and actually work.


