CALL TO ORDER / ESTABLISH QUORUM

- 1. COUNCIL 75 REPRESENTATIVE'S REPORT (Bao Nguyen)
 - a. The Unfair Labor Practice (ULP) has been filed regarding City's refusal to bargain about the return to office mandate.
 - b. A few grievances remain in progress.

2. EXECUTIVE BOARD REPORTS

- a. <u>PRESIDENT'S REPORT</u> (<u>Rob Martineau</u>)
 - i. With the <u>City of Portland Professional Workers Union victory</u>, Portland is now 95% union represented.
 - ii. Several members participated in the <u>NWOLC Labor Appreciation Dinner and</u> <u>Recognition Night</u> we supported. This was a fundraiser event for members facing layoffs.
- b. VICE PRESIDENT'S REPORT (Jacob Brostoff)
 - i. Portland voters approved the Charter change. This change is underway and therefore so is the district mapping. There are <u>multiple proposed map versions</u> being shared with the public to obtain their feedback. The comment period is open until early July. Jacob will host a special meeting to discuss these maps and the potential implications of them.
- c. <u>TREASURER'S REPORT</u> (Chris Richard)
 - i. As discussed in previous meetings, we have updated to the online version of QuickBooks. The online version is now a \$27.50 monthly expense.
