August Digest

Change Requires Action

Hi Todd,

We met recently with our lobbying team to map out our legislative strategy for the 2024 session. We will introduce a limited HIV crime reform bill this year, focusing our efforts on engaging state Senators on our issue. This past year, our bill passed the House but failed to get a hearing in the Senate. We're excited and cautiously optimistic.

This year for Organization Day on November 21 at the Statehouse, we'll be doing something new - we're calling it "HMM Watch." We'll be setting up a general table, and in addition to that, arranging one-on-one meetings between our HMM-trained advocates and their legislators. Additionally, throughout November, we'll be running a general letter campaign to make sure our legislators are aware of the issue of HIV modernization. We'll need your help for the letter campaign, so stay tuned!

Please join us in celebrating Brenton McQueary. Brenton has been living with HIV for 9 years and represents HMM in Bloomington. Brenton spent the first years of his journey navigating living HIV "in the closet" but has recently discovered the personal and societal power of visibility. He lives openly as a person living with HIV and a person in long-term recovery from substance use disorder. Brenton has worked in healthcare for almost his entire life and has spent the last 5 years working with people recovering from substance use disorder. HMM Indiana introduced Brenton to

Brenton recently made a big life/career change in order to allow him to spend his time and apply his passion to combating the HIV epidemic.


