



Nevada Senate Democrats-Field Director

Nevada Senate Democrats are seeking a Field Director to assist in building a program to grow our majority in 2024. The Field Director is responsible for working with individual State Senate campaigns to develop a field program, build a volunteer organization, manage paid canvass operations, and utilize a digital strategy to support field efforts. The position will run through December 2024.

Responsibilities include:

- Drafting and leading the execution of a field plan that includes incumbent protection, open seats, and targeted GOP-held seats
- Assisting in the management of staff
- Facilitating the training and development of field staff
- Managing a paid canvass operation
- Recruiting and engaging volunteers
- Maintaining relationships with partner organizations
- Ensuring that all metrics related to field activities are properly tracked
- Other assigned duties

Qualifications and Skills:

- At least two cycles of field experience on issue or electoral campaigns, with one cycle managing staff
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills
- Good time management skills and ability to manage multiple projects simultaneously
- Extensive experience with Votebuilder
- Willing to work campaign hours, including nights and weekends
- Positive attitude and ability to motivate staff members
- Travel as needed
- Committed to details, results, meeting goals, and tracking/using data to inform decisions
- Ability to approach problem solving with creativity
- Nevada ties a plus, but not required

This position reports directly to the Executive Director. The identified pay range for this position is between \$6,000 and \$8,000 per month plus health care, vision, and dental benefits.
