- Holding assigned candidates accountable to their campaign plans, including canvassing goals and fundraising
- Coordinate with MDLCC's mail and digital vendors to help run the Caucus' buy-in media program
- Assisting other MDLCC staff with fundraising and opposition research
- Developing relationships with political stakeholders, allied organizations, and local Democratic committees
- Other duties as assigned
