RE: Petition Supporting Veto of SB540/HB359

We the undersigned citizens of Florida respectfully request that you veto SB540/HB359 in order to preserve local residents' control of development decisions, protect our water and endangered lands, and to defend taxpayer investments in Everglades restoration.

The language of the bill undermines or directly contradicts several of the priorities you committed to in Executive Order 23-06. This Order was particularly encouraging because it protected local communities ability to make prudent development decisions through the comprehensive planning process. Local communities are often the most vigilant defenders of water resources and remaining wild spaces, and rely on that process to balance competing land use priorities. Several bills passed or proposed this session have eroded local governments' power to express community preferences for land preservation, compact design, and to combat traffic congestion that degrades Floridians' quality of life.

Most troubling is a measure that directly attacks the ability of citizens to mount administrative challenges to legally flawed development decisions. Language in the bill awards prevailing party attorney fees, forcing citizens with good faith concerns to choose between exercising their right to a day in court and potential financial ruin when confronting deep-pocketed developers and lobbyists.

It is not the intent of the American legal system to bankrupt citizens and disproportionately reward litigators on narrowly-decided, highly technical cases. With the context of so many bills undermining the objectives of Order 23-06 seeking to balance growth with quality of life, it is imperative that Floridians' access to the courts not be unduly infringed.

To preserve Floridians' free access to the court system, to further shared objectives of local community control, and to preserve Florida's natural resources for generations to come, it is imperative that you exercise your veto power and reject HB359/SB540.

Thank you for honoring the commitments made in EO 23-06 and for using your authority to defend Floridians' rights.

On behalf of the 5,000 members of the Florida Native Plant Society (FNPS), we ask that you veto SB 540, which would end the ability of individual citizens, and organizations like FNPS, to challenge flawed growth management decisions. If allowed to become law, it would impose prohibitive financial burdens on Floridians who challenge comprehensive plan amendments and preclude their participation in important decisions that threaten local natural resources and other quality-of-life issues. The comprehensive planning process was designed to be inclusive. SB 540 would effectively end any remaining inclusivity. If the intent of the law is to end frivolous lawsuits or improper challenges, existing rules already provide judges with the discretion to award attorney's fees in such cases. Sometimes local governments make bad growth management decisions; SB 540

would take away our ability to challenge even the most egregious decisions.
