Responsibilities

- Directly manage a competitive State House campaign
- Supervise campaign staff, interns, and volunteers
- Manage relationships with vendors, consultants, partner organizations and local groups
- Develop and execute a fundraising plan, manage calltime and events
- Work with FHDCC staff and consultants to develop budgets and paid communications plans
- Respond to press inquiries, build relationships with reporters as appropriate, and draft press releases
- Manage social media profiles
- Draft written content for the campaign

Skills and Qualifications

- A minimum of 1-2 years of relevant experience
- Knowledge of Florida politics and/or state legislative campaigns
- Experience working directly with candidates
- Volunteer management experience
- Experience with Votebuilder, NGP, and ActBlue is desired but not required
