2024 HMM Presenter's Bureau Training

HMM received a [Health Not Prisons](#) grant, part of which went to funding a presenter bureau training. This workshop trained advocates to conduct formal presentations about HMM-Indiana and the topic of HIV criminal law reform. The purpose is to increase HMM capacity to deliver our core messaging to group audiences and recruit people to the HMM-Indiana network. Advocates learned about best practices when presenting, logistics involved in presenter work, and the importance of consistent messaging.
