...what's at stake?

We, your children's educators, are taking action today because recent attacks on federal funding for our public schools will hurt our kids. We hope you'll take a moment to learn more about what's at stake and how to fight back. It's up to us to protect our students, our schools, and our communities.

Current federal efforts to dismantle the Department of Education would decimate vital funding that students rely on in our community. Gutting the Department would mean fewer teachers and support staff, more crowded classrooms, and increased mental health and behavioral challenges.

Nationally, gutting and slashing the Department of Education will hurt our kids:

26 million students will lose critical services designed to get them ahead and on grade level

7.5 million students with disabilities will lose access to special education services funded by the federal government

10 million students from working-class families could lose need-based Pell Grants or subsidized loans, increasing college costs for working-class families

12 million students across all 50 states would lose access to career and technical education programs designed to help them master the skills and knowledge required for employment in today's rapidly changing economy—and for the jobs Trump says he will create

Here in Massachusetts we risk losing the federal funds that provide essential services:

183,000 students with disabilities would lose the support they receive through IDEA

41,000 infants and toddlers would lose the funding that allows them to receive Early Intervention

\$206 MILLION in Title I funding would be stripped from schools across Massachusetts

Dismantling the federal Department of Education and gutting federal support for education and healthcare will put a tremendous strain on our communities. The proposed cuts to Medicare will also cause tremendous harm. We face not just school closures, but hospital closures and more.
