OFFICER REPORTS

- PRESIDENT'S REPORT
 - Council ratified main contract last month. Retro pays are beginning to show up in paychecks.
 - Bargaining in two sub locals (IPR and Auditor's Office) is underway.
 - Port of Portland sub local's TA has been ratified by members, moving forward to Port Commission.
 - Budget and layoffs, we've been in collaboration w/NWOLC and other BUs to actively lobby Council on budget impacts for our members.
 - Layoff/recall protections in contract are intact and we're actively working to avoid the need.
 - Ongoing demand to bargain water security move to interstate
 - Ongoing demand to bargain BSA letter of agreement
 - Officer VACANCIES: Chief Steward, one chapter chair in main contract, one trustee.

- RECORDING SECRETARY'S REPORT
 - Executive Committee Meetings:
 - Nomination and appointment of Jared Longoria to complete the term for the Chapter Chair for accountants. He was appointed by acclamation.
 - There is an omission (of a report) in the previously-approved minutes of Dec 10, 2024. Those minutes will be re-opened and will need to be re-adopted.
 - The Executive Committee met and considered a recommendation from the Member Assistance Committee to authorize expenditure in the amount of \$600 for member assistance to a member in good standing in accordance with established policy. That motion was approved w/o descent.
 - During a meeting of the Executive Board at the Board's strategic planning retreat this weekend, the Board voted unanimously to recommend that the Local endorse Rob Martineau's campaign for Executive Director of Oregon AFSCME. That recommendation will come in the form of a motion under new business.

- Motion to authorize expenditure in an amount not to exceed \$4,000 in contribution to the Portland Public School Bond Renewal Campaign contingent upon contributions totaling or equal or greater amount made by unions whose members are workers directly affected by the outcome of the election. PAC recommendation, no 2nd required, motion carries.
- Motion to adopt E-Board's recommendation to endorse Rob Martineau for Oregon AFSCME Executive Director. E-Board recommendation, no second needed. Motion carries.
- Motion to endorse JoAnn Gillmer for 1st Vice President for Oregon AFSCME. Moved by Tara C. 2nd by Ira B. Motion carries.
- Motion to endorse Ira Bailey for Equity and Inclusion officer. Moved by JoAnn G., 2nd by Audrey Z-D. Motion carries.
- Motion to endorse Sarah Curtis for President. Moved by Tara Carlson, 2nd by Wendy Heckard. Motion carried.
- Motion to approve up to \$1,500 for Union Leave Union Paid from the bargaining budget for up to three members to participate in a bargaining preparation session in April 2025 for the Auditor's Office bargaining where Union Leave City Paid is not available for them. Moved by Minh Dan V., 2nd by Ira Bailey. Motion carries.
- Motion for AFSCME 189 to sponsor/co-sponsor a training for AFSCME members and members of other City Unions related to the City budget. Training would be led by Mark Brenner and potentially co-sponsored by Protec 17. No request for funding at this time. Moved by Mihn Dan V. Motion carried but there was no second before voting began.
