- PRESIDENT'S REPORT
 - EBoard held a strategic planning retreat to outline next two years. # 1 focus is on potential layoffs. We've been actively engaging with City Council to make room in the budget to preserve populated positions as well as vacancies, with some success. There are additional amendments that are still working through Council.
- COUNCIL 75 REPRESENTATIVE'S REPORT
