##### OFFICER REPORTS

- PRESIDENT'S REPORT
  - Really busy, working on lay-offs (two) bumps still working their way through. Many bumps but not separated.
  - Transportation didn't pass. That could impact city budget. PBOT will be heavy hit. Impact remains to be seen.
  - City Council is working to refer parks measure to voters in the November ballot.
- COUNCIL 75 REPRESENTATIVE'S REPORT
  - Negotiations in IPR and Auditors are on-going.
  - Citywide grievance for implementation response due next week.
    - Gayla: Hasn't gone well. City has rejected almost all proposals. Moving into mediation in Aug.
    - Minh Dan: A little behind IPR. Passed lots of proposals, hoping to replicate successes in main unit. Members have shown up strongly. Building out member action team structure. Expect to reach out in fall for solidary.
- VICE PRESIDENT'S REPORT
  - No report
- TREASURER'S REPORT
  - Nothing exciting. A little short of what we expected dues to be. We look ok for the year.
- RECORDING SECRETARY'S REPORT
- There was a meeting of the Executive Committee on June 24. At that meeting the following actions were taken:
  - Motion was raised to authorize funding not to exceed \$1500 per member for up to five members to attend LERC Summer School (Anastasia/David) Motion passed.
  - Motion was raised to approve spending up to \$500 for office supplies, printing, event supplies, and swag in support of the Auditor bargaining campaign. (Minh Dan/Chris). Motion passed.
  - Motion was raised to approve spending up to \$10,000 for legal services related to pay equity for Auditor members and Independent Police Review members, and delegate authority to the Executive Committee/Grievance Committee on when to start and end payment for these services, accepting
